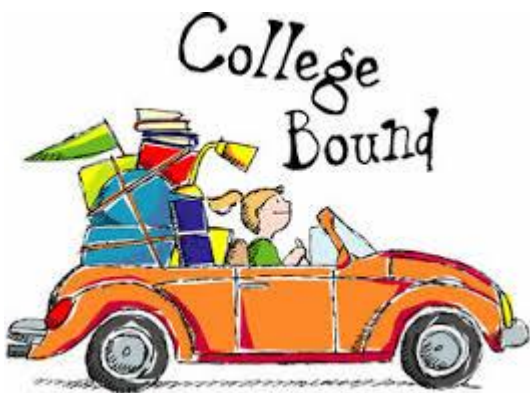

Dear St. Paul Lutheran Congregation,

You are all invited to attend our Holy Week and Easter Services either in-person or via Facebook at: www.stpaultaylor.com. Maundy Thursday and Good Friday Services will be at 12:00 noon and 6:30 PM. The evening Holy Week services and 9:15 AM Easter worship will be available through Facebook. There will be two Easter worship services: Easter Sunrise with Holy Communion at 7:00 AM and 9:15 AM Easter Holy Communion. Following the 9:15 AM worship, there will be an Easter Egg hunt on the lawn at the St. Paul House for our youth.

During this Easter Season, we have an opportunity to demonstrate our faith and commitment to the proclamation of Jesus as our Lord and Risen Savior by inviting our friends and neighbors to join us in worship and prayer. So often the Christian Church is shown in contemporary movies and TV productions as being bigoted, judgmental, and generally angry with those having different life values. After more than forty years in ministry, I have seen the most effective way to proclaim Jesus as our Savior is by positive acts of assistance and forgiveness. The words of Jesus from the cross: "Father forgive them for they know not what they do," has been my daily reminder, especially when my first instinct is to respond negatively to a questionable verbal challenge or slur. I have learned I will never argue anyone into faith in Christ. Rather, I seek to clarify an individual's understanding of who Jesus is and his mission to save humanity from the eternal results of sin and our separation from God. It is the Holy Spirit who moves a person to faith. My goal is to present Christ through the words of Scripture, demonstrate Christ-like actions and invite individuals to explore what faith in Christ can mean for them. In our daily living, we can all do our part to present Jesus to those around us. It is my hope that the divisiveness we feel in our country can be soothed by reflecting on Jesus' sacrificial death on the Cross. Since Christ suffered and died without cursing his enemies, but rather forgave them; as Jesus' disciples should this not also be our life model? Where we see color, race, gender and differing views on life, Jesus saw only God's created and beloved children. As St. Paul reminds us in Galatians 3:28: "...you are all one in Christ Jesus." Jesus was raised from the dead by the power of God the Father to grant all of us both new life today and for all eternity. Satan's control through the power of death was forever defeated both in our living and in our thinking. Christ is Risen! Alleluia!

Our church will be featured in an independent movie entitled *Marisol*, which will be released in about a year and a half. My thanks to the Executive Council members who assisted the film crew on March 19-20. We received a generous donation for the use of our facilities and parking lot.

Once again, I thank you for all your prayers and your continuing support of the ministries of St. Paul Lutheran Church. I look forward to summer and the gradual restarting of in-person activities for our youth and parish education ministries. My you all have safe and joy-filled Easter gatherings with your family and friends.
